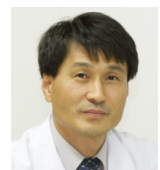

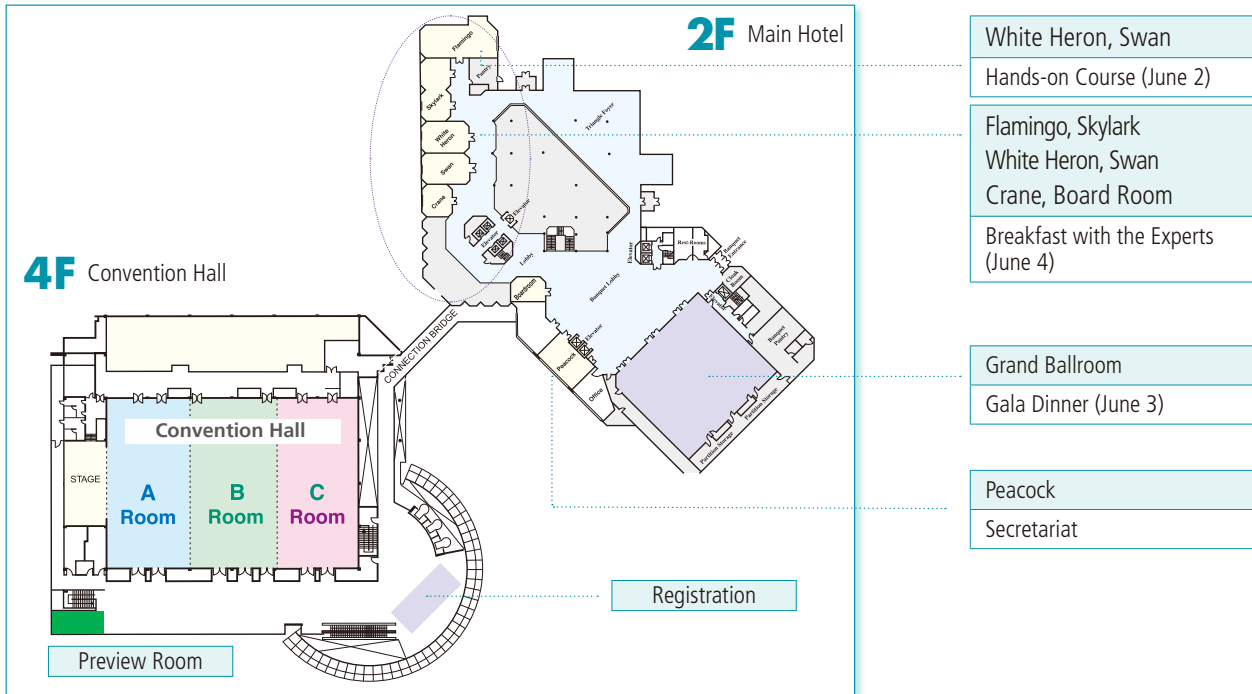

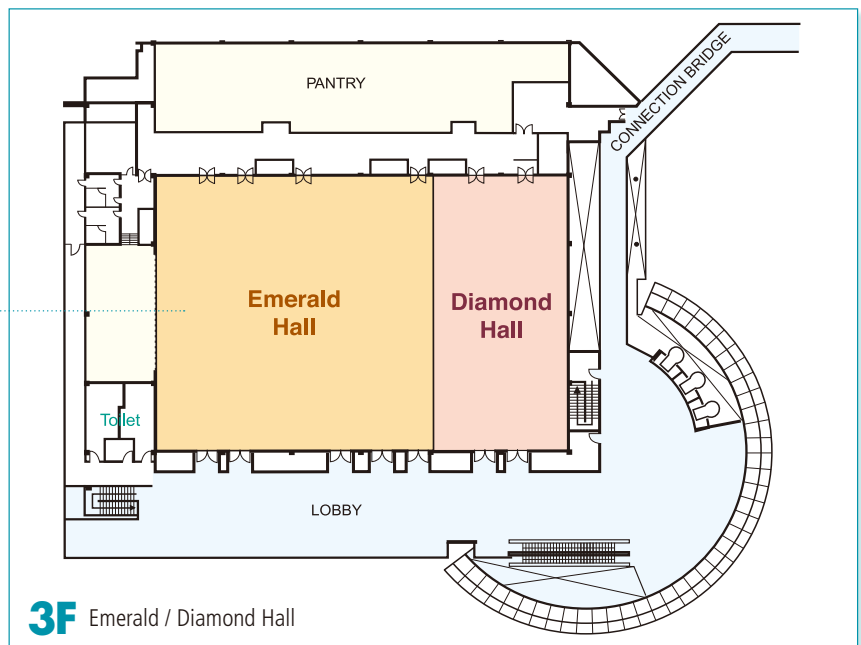


FLOOR PLAN

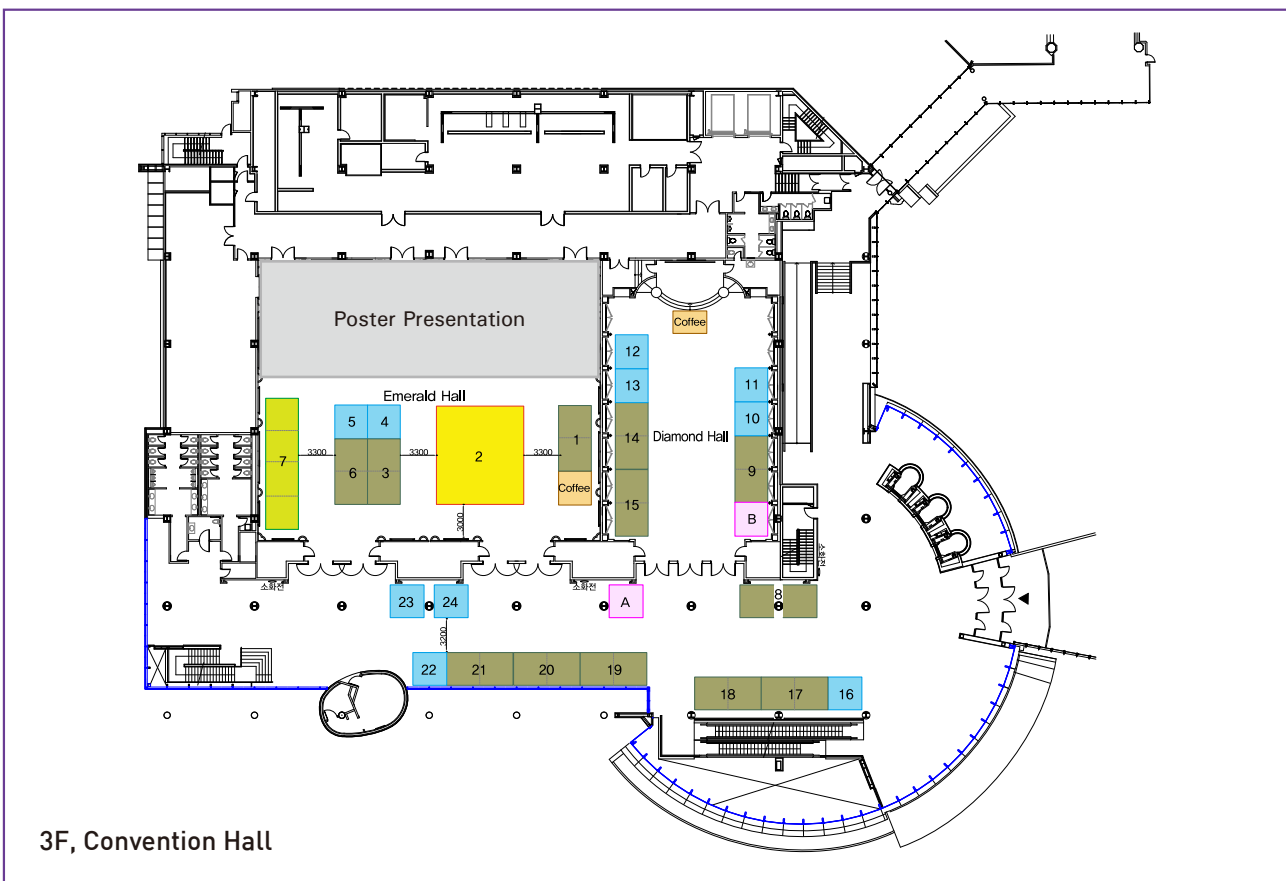

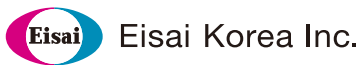
